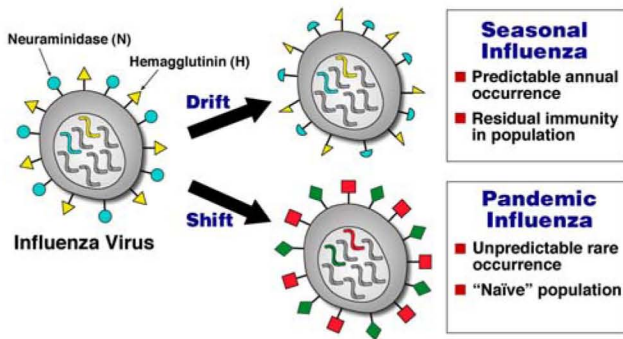


Seasonal vs. Pandemic Influenza



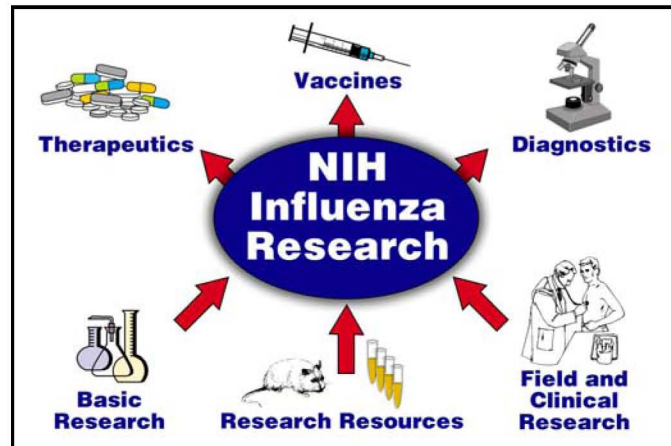
The Burden of Seasonal Influenza

- 250,000 to 500,000 deaths globally/yr; 3-5 million cases of severe illness
- 36,000 deaths and >200,000 hospitalizations/yr in U.S.
- \$37.5 billion in economic costs/yr in U.S. related to influenza and pneumonia

| 1918 H1N1 "Spanish Flu" | >50 million deaths |
| 1957 H2N2 "Asian Flu" | 1-2 million deaths |
| 1968 H3N2 "Hong Kong Flu" | 700,000 deaths |



Basic Research on the 2009 H1N1 Influenza Virus

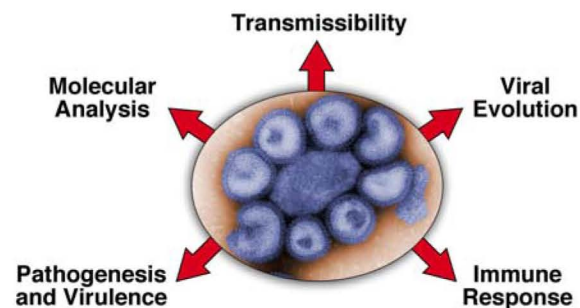
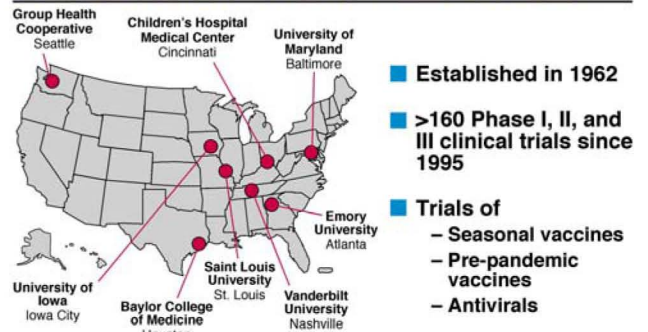
