The Laboratory of Clinical Infectious Diseases (LCID), Division of Intramural Research (DIR), National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) is soliciting applications for a position as a staff clinician in the area of bone marrow transplantation for the treatment of GATA2 deficiency and related immunodeficiency diseases.

The LCID conducts clinical and basic studies of human infectious and immunologic diseases, with an emphasis on the comprehensive understanding and management of patients and their diseases. The LCID focuses on the pathogenesis, pathophysiology, and prevention of infectious diseases.

An enthusiastic and highly motivated clinician will diagnose, treat, and manage patients with GATA2 deficiency and lead clinical protocols relevant to those patient populations at NIAID and the NIH Clinical Center, a state-of-the-art research hospital on the NIH campus in Bethesda, MD. The position will support the bench-to-bedside model of the laboratory, in which therapeutic and research programs take a fully integrated approach, incorporating the molecular genetics of the disease and mechanisms of pathogenesis, leading to the development of new therapeutic approaches. The staff clinician will participate in protocol writing, development, clinical trial operations, clinical research, publication of research articles, and supervision of fellows, students, and residents.

The successful applicant must have an M.D. or equivalent, board certification in internal medicine and/or pediatrics, and have excellent written and verbal communication skills. Subspecialty training in hematology/oncology is recommended but not required. An ideal candidate will have experience in conducting clinical trials and/or clinical research. In addition, an applicant must meet the requirements for credentialing to practice as a staff physician in the NIH Clinical Center. Salary will be at a fair market rate.
